- ❖ If necessary, **You** must obtain HOA approval and/or a fence permit from your Township/Municipality. **Once you secure your permit send us a copy.** Don't procrastinate as this will delay your fence installation. **Save Time and Use our Permit Service - [Click Here](#)**

- ❖ Clearly establish your property lines – A survey may be necessary, where physical stakes are placed on your property
- ❖ Clearly mark any **PRIVATE** underground electric, sprinkler, invisible fencing, pool or propane lines for the pool etc. – **this is VERY IMPORTANT!**
- ❖ Please arrange your schedule to be present at the start of the project to greet our crew, review the entire project, provide water and electricity and arrange for final payment on the day of completion. Ideally, it is great if you can be present for the duration of the project, however this is not required.
- ❖ Any changes to the scope of the project **MUST** be finalized prior to the date of install. This will avoid any premium fees or charges for changes once we have mobilized. Contact our offices or our fencing specialist that designed your project with you.
- ❖ **Inclement Weather greatly impacts our installation schedule and as a result quoted lead times could be longer than originally stated.**

Please pay close attention to the items listed above to ensure a timely and efficient fence installation. Some items may not apply to you due to the details pertaining to your fence.
